Accommodation:

Students either stay in a 'homestay' situation or live with their family. Homestays are families who provide a room and meals for students and care for their everyday needs. The College does not provide living accommodation as this is usually organised by the ELICOS school the student is attending.

If required, however, we will provide assistance for students having difficulty finding Homestay. Please refer to the Homestay link.

Guardian/Local Carer:

Visa condition 8532 requires that students under 18 years of age maintain suitable accommodation, support and general welfare arrangements. Students under 18 years old may stay with a parent or suitable relative or, if this is not possible, they may stay in accommodation approved by their education provider.

If the student is not residing with a parent or legal custodian, or in accommodation approved by the education provider, the student can reside with a relative who is:

- a grandparent, brother, sister, aunt, uncle, niece or nephew, or a step-grandparent, step-brother, step-sister, step-aunt, step-uncle, step-niece or step-nephew;
- nominated by a parent of the applicant or a person who has custody of the applicant;
- aged at least 21; and
- of good character.

On reaching 18 years of age, an overseas student studying at Aranmore, must continue in accommodation approved by Aranmore as indicated above. That is a student may not live alone or with a group of young people.
