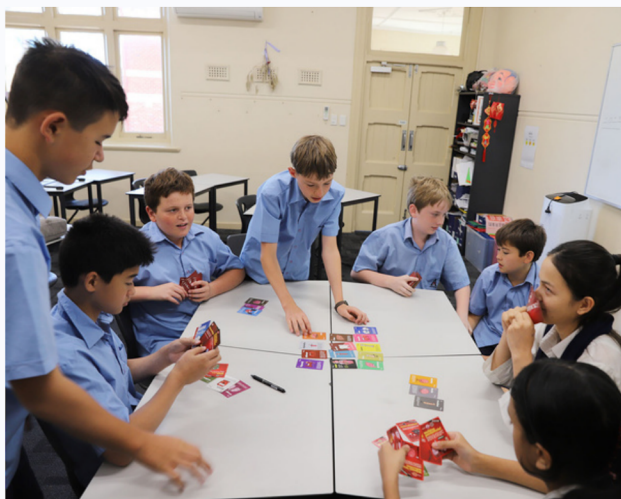
REASONS TO STUDY AT ARANMORE

20 YEARS OF INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION

Send your child to a school that prides itself as being multicultural.

With an established International Student Program your child will have access to;

- an office where students can access for any pastoral care requirements;
- 24-hour contact with the international student coordinator; and
- a dedicated team of staff supporting student needs.



FUTURE PATHWAYS

Pathways to Australian TAFE programs and Universities in Western Australia, and Australia after the completion of Year 12 for all students. Our international students enter into both ATAR and General pathways in Year 11 and 12.

AFFORDABILITY

Tuition fees are competitive compared with similar independent Australia schools as well as international schools in Vietnam.

TALK TO A PERSON

The school directly speaks with parents, agents and homestays! Any issues or problems will be dealt with by a person *in* the school.

GENUINE CARE

We understand that when you are in a new country it can be tough! Students are provided with a school orientations, they are shown the Perth Study hub and have access to a Coordinator 24/7 to answer any questions... from driving lessons, jobs and homestay issues!

Parents are welcome to contact the International Student coordinator to receive updates about their child and to discuss any issues.

BEAUTIFUL PERTH

Students can enjoy a safe and quiet life in Perth, close to some of the most beautiful coast line in the world and a relaxed pace of life. Many of our students find part time jobs, which provides real-work experiences outside of school.

COMMON QUESTIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

ABOUT THE COLLEGE AND PERTH

Aranmore Catholic College welcomes international students to study with us in Years 7-12.

The College is located a short distance (3km) from the Perth CBD (10-minute drive) in a suburb called Leederville. The Perth Study Hub is located in the CBD and is a support centre for international students. Many students take public transport or walk to the College.

Perth is one of the most livable cities in the world, with a warm climate, enviable beaches, relaxed lifestyle and is in the same time zone as Asia. There are world class universities located in Perth and strong job opportunities.

START AND FINISH

School starts at 8:40am and finishes at 3:15pm Monday to Friday, except an earlier finish on Thursday at 2:30pm. Students have a 10 minute pastoral lesson each day where they meet with their form teacher.

WELLBEING

We are not a 'big' school, with approximately 700 students, therefore our teachers are able to support students and their needs. Teachers know students and celebrate their successes.

Each child is supported by a:

- Form teacher
- Dean of Students
- Student services including counsellor and careers adviser

Students are able to contact the International Student Coordinator 24 hours a day and they can message their teachers easily via SEQTA.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Yes, they are available! Please enquire directly with the College.

LIVING ARRANGEMENTS

There is no boarding available at the College.

Aranmore Catholic College uses the Australia Homestay Network (AHN) for all homestay requirements. If a child has a direct relative they wish to stay with, the student can choose to live with an approved guardian.

WACE AND CLASSES

From Year 7 - 10 students complete a general education based on the Australian Curriculum. Class sizes are approx. 25-30 students.

The Year 11-12 program allows students to achieve the Western Australia Certificate of Education (WACE). This is a 2-year program, where students work in an ATAR, General or Foundation pathway. ATAR leads into university and General leads to TAFE. Class sizes are generally smaller with 15 -20 students. In 2022 96% of university applications received their first or second choice of university.

English as an Additional Language or Dialect (EAL/D) and Religion are compulsory subjects at the Year 11 and 12 level.

STEPS TO ENROLMENT

1. Complete and Submit an Application for Enrolment form. (signed by student and parent)
2. Prepare documentation including passport, school reports, homestay details, recent photo, english test AEAS
3. Interview
4. Offer and Acceptance
5. Arrival at Aranmore Catholic College, Orientation and meet and greet with Principal
